CAMS for Students trains young ministers from the ages of 14 through 22, and is comprised of four phases: Explore, Equip, Engage, and Empower. This process will provide partnerships, networking, internship, and licensure. It will enhance the ability for the younger generation to serve through their calling.

THE PROGRAM AT A GLANCE



Connect and Register

Students connect during Youth Department gatherings, such as Youth Camp, Winterfest, and Teen Talent. The office of Ministerial Development will form a partnership with pastors, families, and state/regional offices, to connect with individuals who could participate in CAMS for Students.



Top-Tier Resources and Training Materials

CAMS for Students includes the book *CALLED*, which introduces the student to the six principles of ministry. The students will also work through material from the School of Ministry that includes topics of ministerial foundation, psychology, and the history of the church.



Seminars and Retreat

CAMS for Students is a four-month training experience, consisting of in-person and virtual seminars, concluding with a Calling Retreat.
